## **Special Call For “Ignite-style” Proposals Highlighting Dr. Virginia Saba’s Contributions to Informatics for AMIA 2022 Annual Symposium Late Breaking Session**

The AMIA 2022 Annual Symposium will include an in-person late breaking session honoring Dr. Virginia Saba. The NIWG leadership team is accepting “Ignite-style” session proposals that highlight Dr. Saba’s many contributions to informatics, education, research, and practice.

**Proposals are due September 7, 2022.** Selected attendees will be notified by October 7, 2022, and will have five minutes each to present their Ignite-style talk accompanied by slides, automatically advanced.

**Selected proposals will be timely, provocative, and creative addressing innovative and up-and-coming ideas in excellence in nursing informatics that highlight or relate to some aspect of Dr. Saba’s work. ignite us!**

For example, the presentation can:

- Describe research or an educational activity
- Tell a story
- Promote a new program
- Advocate for a policy initiative
- Illustrate a lesson learned

### **Ignite-style Format Rules:**

- Your Ignite-style talk will contain exactly 20 slides, 15 seconds each, automatically advanced.
- You must use the Ignite-style PowerPoint slide template provided by AMIA.
- After your presentation, a moderator will facilitate brief dialogue with the audience and move to the next presentation.
- Ignite-style Talks will be pre-loaded on a laptop, and you will be required to submit a final version of your presentation slides in advance.

The submission must be formatted to fit one page (8.5 x 11 inch) document and must include:

- Your name, academic degree(s), affiliations, and location (city, state, and country, if international).
- A brief (50-75 words) abstract.
- A description of your presentation and an outline of your content.
